Action Items from January 27, 2026 meeting

- Discussed and voted to approve payment of the bills
- Discussed and voted to terminate correctional facility part time cook for no show/no call
- Discussed and voted to approve Updated Whistleblower policy
- Discussed and voted to approve Updated Conflict of Interest policy
- Discussed and voted to reluctantly approve resignation of Michael Rogers as our Recycling Center Director
- Discussed and voted to approve expenditure of \$3,464 for wireless conferencing and presentation system for 911 center to upgrade from outdated equipment out of Act 13 funds. An additional \$36,209 will be covered and paid directly by PEMA.
- Discussed and voted to approve administrative entity operating agreement renewal between Wyoming and Luzerne Counties Mental Health and Developmental Services
- Discussed donating unused sign making equipment to Wyoming County COG for use by townships and boroughs to make street signs

Action Items to be Acted on Today

- Discuss and vote to approve payment of the bills
- Discuss and vote to sign a letter of support for Tunkhannock Borough Municipal Authority to apply for a Consumption Use Mitigation Grant through the Susquehanna River Basin Commission for advanced metering infrastructure water meters throughout their service area.
- Discuss and vote to request assistance from DCED to study a county wide EMS system through the Endless Mountains Medical Center and Foundation.

- Discuss and vote to approve an unused wide printer that in the 911 center on Municibid. This equipment has not been used in 4 to 5 years and it is not anticipated it will ever be needed. There is a wide printer in the assessment office if there is ever a need by 911 or EMA
- Discuss and vote to sign a purchase of Service agreement one year renewal with White Deer Run, LLC dba Cove Prep
- Discuss and vote to sign a temporary shelter agreement with Anytime Fitness for a shelter for employees at the Wyoming County Human Services if we ever need to evacuate. This is similar to the one already in place with the Tunkhannock Methodist Church for courthouse employees in case an evacuation is required
- Discuss and vote to send a letter to Factoryville Borough and Clinton Township asking for a meeting with them to discuss their decision to stop recycling in their municipalities
- Discuss and vote to sign renewal agreements with Trehab for MATP Medical Assisted Transportation Program. All costs are paid by Trehab and no cost to the county.
