

Wyoming County Marcellus Legacy Fund Mini Grant Instructions and Guidelines

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Through the Marcellus Legacy Fund distributed to Wyoming County, the Commissioners have dedicated \$50,000.00 to implement a Mini Grant Program. This program will provide mini-grants of up to \$5,000.00 to projects that support and advance the goals and objectives of the Marcellus Legacy Fund. The use of these funds include acquisition, development and repair of greenways, recreation trails, open space, natural areas, community conservation and beautification projects, community and heritage parks and water resource management. Mini-Grants require a 50% local match in the form of cash and/ore ligible non-cash (in-kind) services. (Example – Grant request=\$5,000, Match = \$2,500)

- In-kind match the value of municipal labor and/or professional services is equal to the hourly billable rate multiplied by the number of hours performing that service or job. The value of volunteer in-kind will be valued at the current Independent Sector Volunteer Rate for Pennsylvania at the time the work was performed please visit http://www.independentsector.org/volunteer_time for current volunteer value.
- Applicants must provide proof of match commitment.

The Marcellus Legacy Fund Mini-Grant Program is a reimbursement-funding program. Costs should be described in the budget and will be paid only to the extent that they are incurred by the Grantee in performance of the Projects Scope of Work. Awardees can receive three reimbursement distributions in conjunction with submission of Phased project reports.

Eligibility

Who is eligible?

Eligible applicants include non-profit organizations with tax-exempt status 501(c)(3), munic ipalities and educational institutions.

Non-profit organizations must submit proof of non-profit status and be registered with the PA Department of State Bureau of Charitable Organizations.

What kind of project is eligible?

Eligible projects should advance the Goals and Objectives of the Marcellus Legacy Fund and be consistent with the Wyoming County Comprehensive Plan and the Northern Tler Open Space, Greenway, and Outdoor Recreation Plan.

All projects must be located within Wyoming County.

All projects should advance the goal of Site Master Plans or Trail Feasibility Study.

Application Submission

Format:

- The application can be downloaded from the Wyoming County Office of Community Planning. (www.wycopa.org/Offices/Community Planning)
- Application narratives should be clear and concise.
- The application can be submitted by mail, email or in person.
- When submitting by email, all required supporting documents should be attached as a PDF documents and should be identified as your application's documents.

All applicants will receive an email confirmation of receipt of application. If you do not receive this email you need to contact us by phone at 570-996-2268 to ensure that your application was received and will be considered.

• Mail or hand de live ry:

If you are unable to submit the application electronically, the completed application and required documents may be mailed or hand delivered in enough time for the application to be received at the Wyoming County Community Planning Office (address on page 1) no later than 3:00 pm on May 2, 2023.

Mailed or hand de live red applications received after this date and time will not be considered.

Applicant Responsibility:

- Identify projects that support the purpose, vision, and goals of the Marcellus Legacy Fund, Wyoming County Comprehensive Plan and Northern Tier Open Space, Greenway and Outdoor Resource Plan.
- Secure local match at a minimum of 50% (can be cash and/or in-kind services).
- Provide letters of commitment from partners providing local match; letters should describe the type of program assistance, match amount and how that partner is contributing to the success of the project.
- Demonstrate the ability to complete project on time and within budget.
- Submit application on time by 3:00 pm on May 2, 2023.
- For non-profit applicants; provide current proof of IRS 501(c)3 non-profit status and registration with the PA Bureau of Charitable Organizations.

Application Review:


Applications will be ranked on criteria set by a review committee.

Applicants will be ranked based on how well the project:

- ♦ Supports and advances the goals and objectives of the Marcellus Legacy Fund, Wyoming County Comprehensive Plan and the Northern Tier Open Space, Greenway, and Outdoor Recreation Plan.
- \Diamond Promotes partner collaboration.
- ♦ Identifies and secures required match.
- ♦ Develops a realistic budget.
- ♦ Demonstrates that the project will have measurable outcomes and be successful.
