

As required by HAVA (Help America Vote Act of 2002) If you are an absentee voter who is voting for a federal office, and/or are voting for the first time in the County, and have registered by mail on or after January 1, 2003, and have not already submitted proper identification, you are required to submit a proper form of identification with your ballot.

Approved forms of photo identification:

(ID must be valid)

- PA driver's license or ID card issued by PennDot
- ID issued by any other Commonwealth agency
- ID issued by the U.S. Government
- U.S. Passport
- U.S. Armed Forces ID
- Student ID
- Employee ID

Due to changes in the federal and state laws; you are now required to return your voted absentee ballot by means of:

Approved forms of non-photo identification

(ID must include the name and address of the elector)

- Voter's identification card issued by the voter registration commission
- Non-photo ID Issued by the commonwealth
- Non-photo issued by the U.S. Government
- Firearm permit
- Current bank statement
- Current paycheck
- Government check
