Rick Wilbur, Chairman called the meeting to Order at 9:10 a.m. following the Wyoming County Prison Board Meeting.

Ernie King moved to approve the June 9th and 11th, 2020 Meeting Minutes. Tom Henry second the Motion. Motion carried.

Commissioners Report:

1. Meeting and Tele-Conference related to reopening PA and the numerous Grant Programs.
2. New regulations for Commissioners serving as the Assessment Appeals Board. They must undergo a 12 hour Training Program, which will be completed remotely and must be completed by June 30, 2020.

Commissioner received great news on Thursday from Jeff Porter, 911 Director that 911 Advisory Committee voted against the new funding proposal based on population. We are hopeful that 100% of our 911 funding will be secure for at least the next two or three years.

Tom Henry, Commissioner gave an update on the Mental Health Public Hearing.

Commissioners along with Labella Engineering toured County Bridge #2 and #6 which are in need of repairs to the Deck #6 Superstructure #2. Improvement to the Road will be completed by Exeter Twp. and Conservation District, (if funds are available).

Rick Wilbur moved to give Robert Roberts, Sheriff approval to advertise for a Part-Time Deputy Sheriff. Tom Henry second the Motion. Motion carried.

Rick Wilbur, Chairman reported the County will received \$1,071,042.00 for Act 13, with \$25,000.00 going into the Legacy Account.

Tom Henry moved to close the Roadside Rest on Rt 29 South until further notice. Rick Wilbur second the Motion. Motion carried.

Rick Wilbur, Chairman announced that both Unions, SEIU and AFSCME approved a Union Contract Extension through December 31, 2021, including a 25 cent an hour increase. The Commissioners thanked the employees in accepting this offer.

Commissioners authorized the County Treasurer to open the account called COVID-19 Disaster Fund.

There being no further business to come before the Commissioners at this time. Tom Henry made the Motion to adjourn. Ernie King second the Motion. Motion carried
