Action Items from January 30, 2024 meeting

- Voted to approve funding of \$105,200 to CEO for improvements, coolers, freezers and other moving costs into the new building being purchased. In addition to providing food services to Wyoming County residents, they are instrumental in handling a myriad of other social services including aid to homeless, poor and others and are our go to resource almost on a daily basis. Funds will be made from an ARP grant after the final sale is completed.
- Voted to proclaim March 28 as Casual Day to promote Colon Cancer Awareness and provide funding for the Northeast Regional Cancer Institute to support colorectal screenings for low income and uninsured or underinsured individuals.
- Voted to accept resignation of CO Nancy Petula effective April 30, 2024. Consult with Warden Repsher that she would be willing to fill in on a part time basis as her schedule permits.
- Voted to approve funding of approximately \$35,000 (will vary based on participation) for a Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Event on November 23, 2024. Details will be given as soon as more planning is done. Funding will come of Act 13 Marcellus funds.
- Voted to proclaim March as Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month.
- Discussed and voted to approve D&Y contracts
- Voted to promote Makayla Flynn from part time to full time at correctional facility
